Janet is passionate about the fullness of Christ being manifest in this generation and is laboring to see The Salvation Army become an Army on its knees.

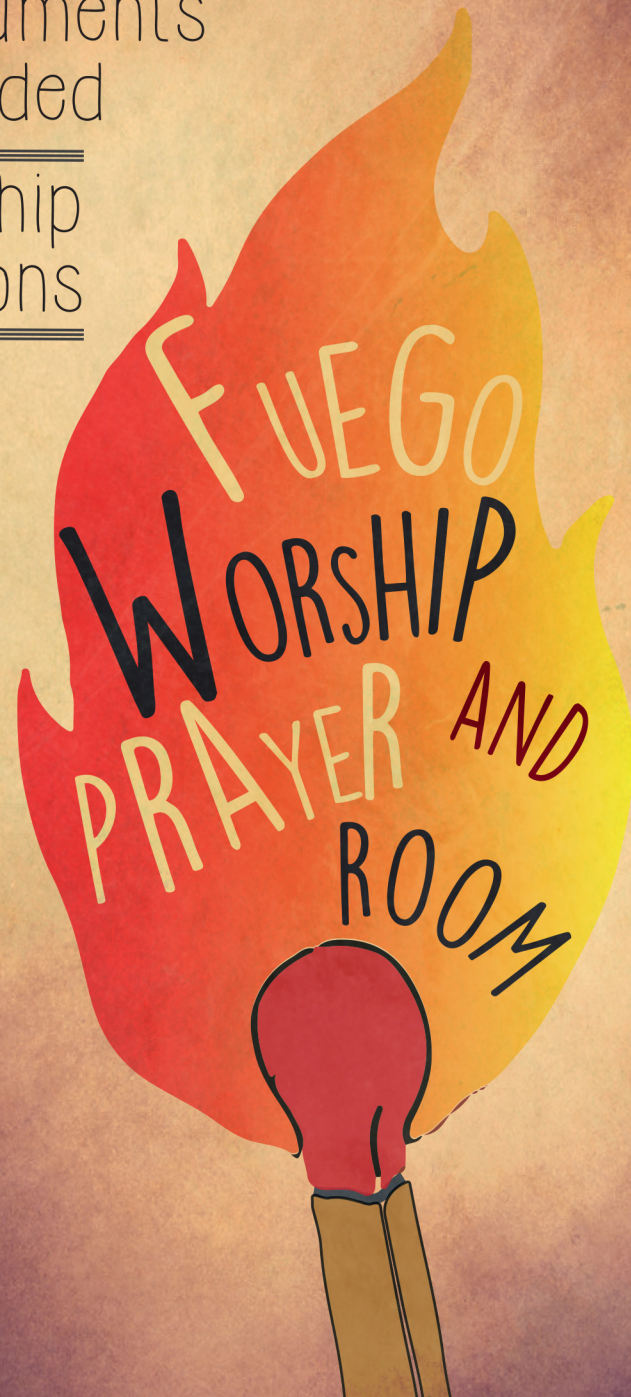

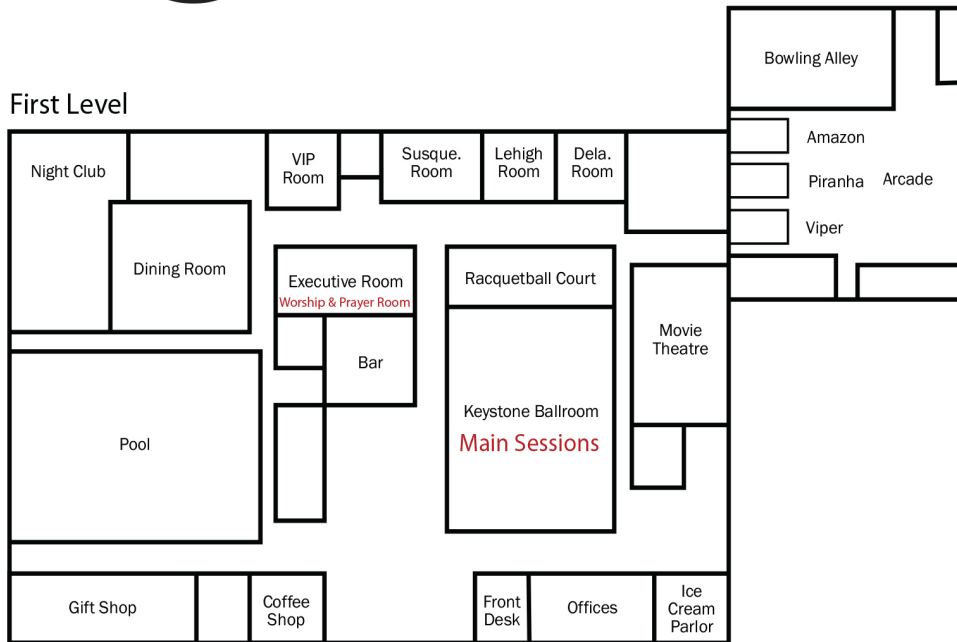

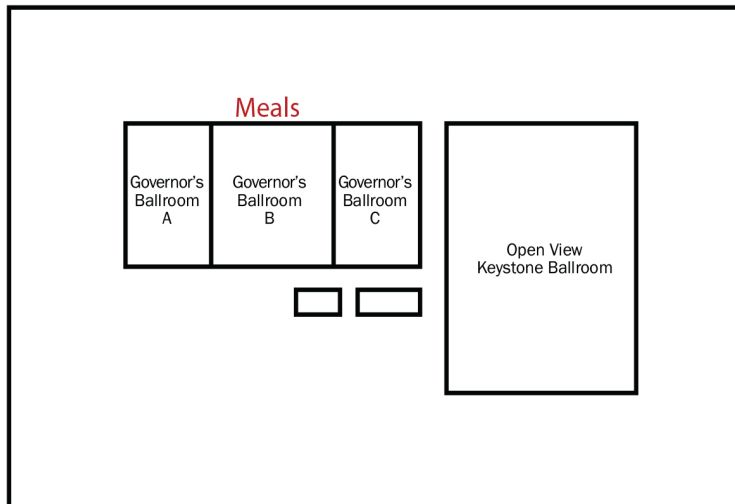
